## Fire Pan Tip Sheet

Thank you for your order. There are a few things you should know about this fire pan before using this product.

- -This is the lightest Fire pan on the market at 26lbs.
- -We recommend painting the steel pan, **before it's first use**, with a heat resistant paint. Rustoleum makes several varieties.

  - Do Not Paint the legs, aluminum top, or Grill
- \_The grill design helps keep the weight down so there is a limit to the amount of weight it will hold without supporting the free hanging side. You can always put a rock or empty can under the unsupported side to stabilize the unit, if you are loading in up with your favorite meat and veggies.
- The fire Pan bag is designed to contain the pan and protect your gear. It has openings that allow access to the metal handles of the pan. This allows you to secure the pan utilizing the handles of the pan and not just the bag. This design feature was created after a violent raft flip ripped a competitors pan out of it's bag and left the boatman with a sweet piece of webbing as a souvenir.
